Celebrating 80 years...

The Woodford County Conservation District celebrates its 80th anniversary this year. That certainly pre-dates most people reading this! We do not take the past for granted, nor the change that has occurred since 1946, and your Conservation District looks forward to another 80 years of service to the wealth of natural resources that make Woodford County what it is.

Every county in Kentucky has a Conservation District, established in response to the Dust Bowl and, to some extent, the Great Depression of the 1930s. Your Woodford County Conservation District has, for 80 years, sought to promote and protect the conservative management of natural resources through outreach and education and by coordinating local, state and federal resources to strengthen locally-led conservation priorities. Leadership comes in many forms. Though Conservation Districts in Kentucky are subdivisions of state government in statute, we are funded through County tax dollars and governed by a board of seven elected Supervisors. Our Board of Supervisors has long been made up of dedicated conservationists, whose example is one of the most impactful forms of leadership there is. Throughout the rest of this year, we will be highlighting individuals in this community whose work and service mostly goes unnoticed, but whose impact on this idyllic bluegrass landscape will undoubtedly last another 80 years.

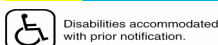

AG WATER QUALITY

The Agriculture Water Quality Act requires landowners with 10 or more acres that are being used for agriculture or silviculture operations to develop and implement an ag. water quality plan (AWQP). It is the sole responsibility of each landowner to develop, implement, and revise their plan.

The AWQP is made up of best management practices (BMPs) that cover 6 different areas: silviculture, pesticides and fertilizers, farmstead, crops, livestock, and streams and other waters. The Woodford County Conservation District can assist with planning and implementation via technical assistance and cost-share funding programs. **An up-to-date AWQP is required to receive funding through cost-share programs in Kentucky.**
