This cost share practice will pay \$20 per acre, up to 100 acres, for the planting of a cover crop after a primary crop has been harvested in late summer/early fall. There is a 75-acre maximum cover cropping after tobacco.

The eligible cover crop species for this program are wheat and rye. Cover crops planted through this program CAN be harvested for grain or forage (grazing is also allowed).

**The following documents must be turned in to the WCCD office:** 1. this form, 2. your receipts for seed, 3. FSA form 578, and 4. a map indicating the acres and fields planted. Woodford County Conservation District encourages all producers to report cover crops to the FSA office located in the Agriculture Resource Building.

The cover crop must be **planted before December 1st to be eligible for payment.**

This program is on a first come-first served basis until funding has run out. Spot checks will be conducted by the Woodford County Conservation District Board. All funding is subject to board approval.
