Rock Gateway Program

A wet season often results in our gateways being excessively rutted and eroded. The purpose of this program is to help Woodford County farmers with the necessary means to repair gateways in order to reach an area of the farm that makes it difficult for animals or machinery to cross the majority of the year.

The Conservation District will provide materials to install filter fabric covered by 4-6" stone at no cost to the participant (if <4yrs participating).

Limited to 1 gateway per farm owner per fiscal year Fall sign-ups will run until September 22, 2023



Field Cover Crop

This cost share practice will pay \$20/acre for up to 100 acres, for planting a cover crop after harvest of corn or soybeans in the fall of 2023.

This cost share practice will also pay \$20 per acre for up to 50 acres, for planting a cover crop after harvest of tobacco in fall 2023.

Can be wheat or rye, and can be harvested for grain; grazed or harvested for forage; as well as planted into, in the spring. Other cover crops will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Garden Cover Crop

Working with Tyson Gregory, the new Horticulture Extension Agent; and Woodford County Master Gardeners, WCCD will provide bags of seed for FREE for backyard garden cover crops!

Cover crops in your garden provide multiple benefits such as controlling erosion, suppressing weeds, reducing soil compaction, increasing moisture and nutrient content of soil, improving yield potential, attracting pollinators, and providing habitat for beneficial insects and wildlife!

UNLIMITED FREE SOIL TESTS

As of July 1, 2023, the Board of Supervisors has lifted the 20per-year cap on free soil tests.

This means EVERYONE in Woodford County can benefit from ALL the soil testing they could possibly need in a year!

All private land and farm soil testing is now fully sponsored by the Woodford County Conservation District. Commercial entities are not eligible - i.e. landscaping or pesticide companies.

Dead Animal Removal - now \$125 per animal!

The Board of Supervisors has voted to increase the reimbursement for the composting of large fallen animals in Woodford County from \$100 per animal to \$125 per animal.

To apply for cost-share reimbursement, bring in or email a copy of your collection receipt (incl. farm pickup address, date, collection company), as well as to whom you'd like the reimbursement check made out (your name or Farm name), and address to where you'd like it sent.


