Rock Gateway Program

The Woodford County Conservation District's (WCCD) Rock Gateway Program incentivizes installation of geotextile fabric and rock in farm gateways to minimize soil erosion. Incentive is based on past participation and priority is given to individuals with fewer years of participation if applications exceed budgeted funding.

1st year of participation: **no cost to participant**

2nd year of participation: **75% cost share**

3rd year of participation: **50% cost share**

4th year of participation: **25% cost share**

Applications accepted until June 30 or until capacity is reached.

Who is eligible:

- Farms **25 acres or greater**
- Sole Proprietors, multi-member businesses and partial owners (approval is limited to one gateway per individual entity or farm - owners of more than one farm cannot be approved for two farms in the same program year)
- Tenants and operators with a current FSA-902 Farm Operating Plan

What is provided:

- 40 feet of geotextile fabric picked up at the Conservation District office
- Up to 25 tons of rock (*dense grade, crushed stone base, or #2 rock*) + delivery from Harrod Concrete and Stone

Terms and Conditions:

- *Participants are limited to one gateway per fiscal year.*
- Only gateways connecting two fields are eligible; site prep, geotextile fabric and rock spreading must be done according to program guidelines.
- Scheduling and ordering of material must be done through Harrod Concrete and Stone according to program guidelines after notification of approval has been received from the Woodford County Conservation District.
- All rock delivered must be used on a single gateway. The load cannot be split or used for other purposes.
- The Conservation District (859-873-4941 Ext. 3, woodfordcd@gmail.com) must be notified as soon as the gateway is completed, including photos of the gateway and its surroundings.
- The Conservation District is granted permission to conduct a site inspection at any time after completion and is granted the right to use any completion photos for promotional and educational purposes
- Invoices for the participant's share of the rock expense must be paid within 60 days.
- Gateway must be complete before June 30th.
